- SIGN 8a: Roxy Complex Tenants after 1936
- SIGN 9: Maitland Street East – Cunningham to Heber Street
- SIGN 9a: Mansfield Family Plumbers
- SIGN 10: Regional Australia Bank to Veterinary Clinic
- SIGN 11: Soldiers Memorial Hall
- SIGN 12: The Commercial Hotel
- SIGN 13: The Regent Theatre/Civic Centre
- SIGN 14: Imperial Hotel to the Sportsmans Hotel
- SIGN 15: The Imperial Hotel
- SIGN 16: Bingera/Bingara Post Office

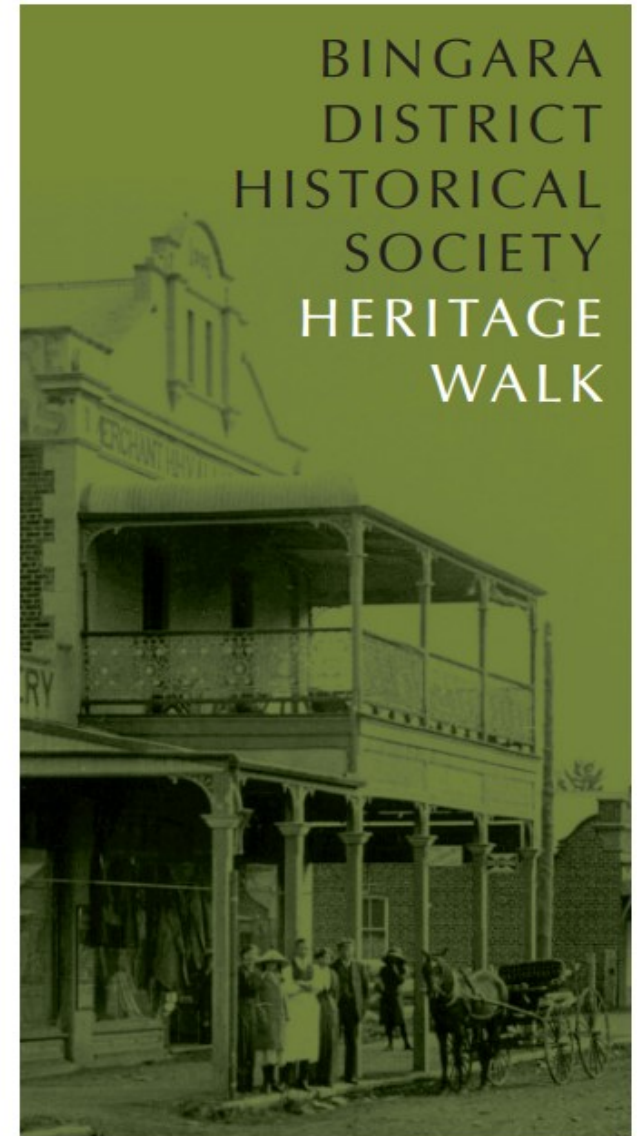

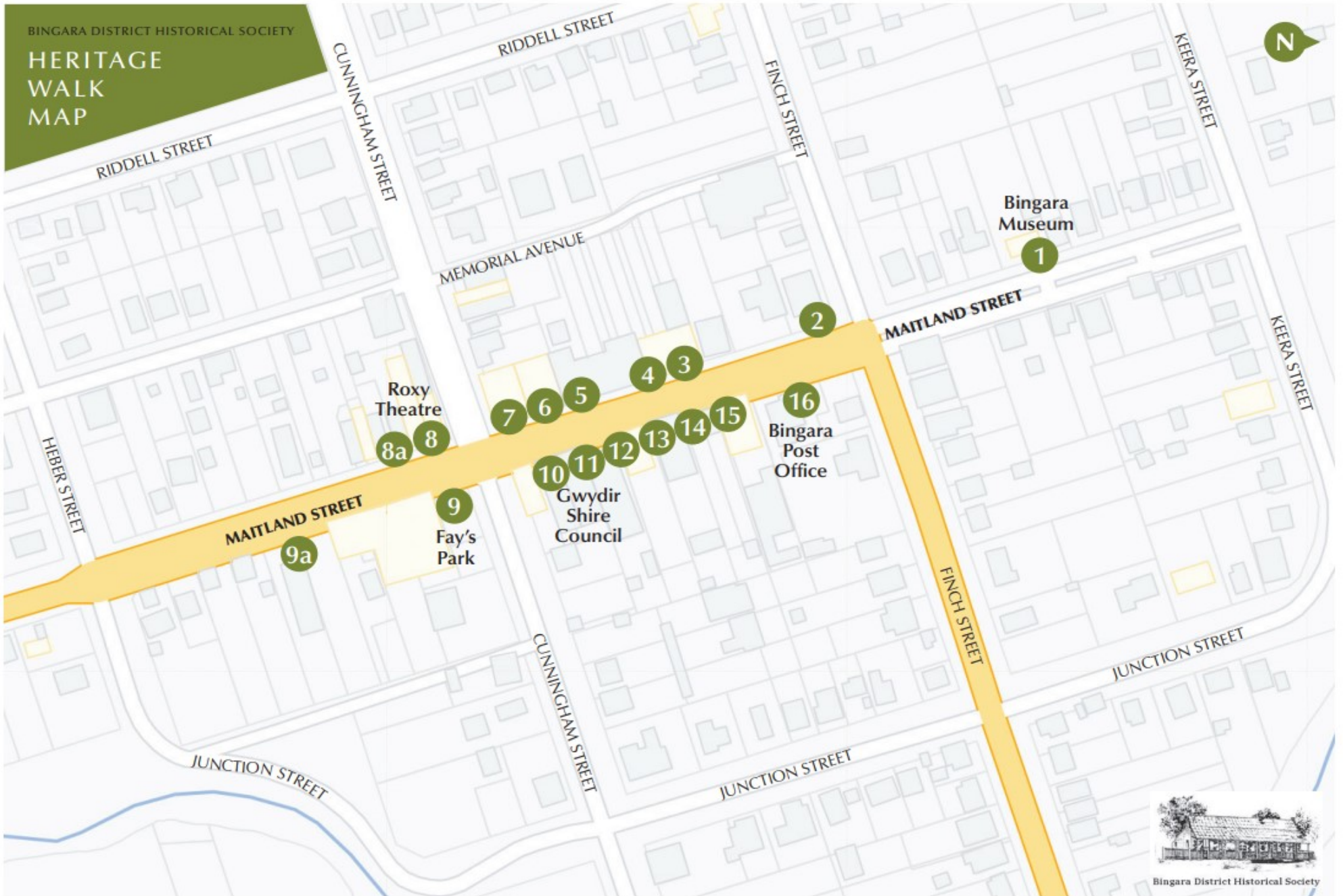
